TO THE STUDENT APPLICANT:

Litho Club of Baltimore scholarship applications are being accepted from graduating high school seniors and/or college students. Only students meeting the following criteria will be considered by the scholarship committee.

1. Applicants must have a current grade point average of 2.5 based on this year's transcripts.
2. Applicants must provide proof of application or college acceptance (a copy of your application and/or acceptance letter must be submitted as soon as possible).
3. Applicants must be enrolled in a high school or post-secondary approved print communications or computer graphic design career completer program.
4. Unless otherwise specified by the donor organization, awards will be based on a combination of academic achievement, technical program achievement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need. Special emphasis will be placed on each individual's character, personal merit and background. Merit is demonstrated in a variety of ways: leadership in school, civic and other extra-curricular activities, academic achievement, and motivation to serve and succeed in all endeavors.
